



The TRIO Upward Bound (UB) program at West Virginia University Institute of Technology (WVU Tech) is funded through the United States Department of Education to serve students that attend a high school in Fayette or Raleigh County. The TRIO UB program provides opportunities for program participants to succeed in high school and prepare for post-secondary education. The program serves high school students from low-income families and high school students from families in which neither parent holds a bachelor's degree.

As part of the TRIO UB program, participants live on the WVU Tech campus in Beckley, WV for six weeks during the summer to prepare for the upcoming school year as well as college campus visits, cultural trips and more! During the academic year, the program hosts monthly "Monthly Meetings" for students regarding ACT and SAT preparation, college campus visits, decision making, paying for college and more. Best of all, all services provided by the program are **FREE!**

Students participating in the program receive a monthly stipend for actively participating in the during the school year. In addition, students taking part in the summer program can earn an additional stipend for participating. Upperclassmen can apply to work on campus during the summer program and earn an additional stipend.

If you qualify and are accepted into the WVU Tech TRIO UB program, you will have access to the following services in addition to the summer program:

In addition to the selection criteria mentioned above, interested students must be a United States citizen or permanent resident, show a desire to attend college after high school and must be enrolled in a Fayette or Raleigh County high school.
